The Betty Proctor Fund (BPF) provides once-in-a lifetime assistance for individuals or families who have a need that threatens their self-sufficiency and that cannot be met through their own resources.

- Clients served- Jefferson County, Denver County, and those who identify as homeless.
- Each client may receive one-time assistance from the Betty Proctor Fund.
- A community agency representative must submit the application on behalf of the client.
- All applications must be completed in full and include supporting documentation. A complete application includes how the client will pay for this expense in the future.
- Payments are sent directly to vendors.
- It may take up to two weeks for an application to be processed.
- The Betty Proctor Fund will contribute up to the **last \$100 of the expense.**

The Betty Proctor Fund can often be awarded to assist with:

Appliance Replacement or Home repair
Crime Victims
Education- such as GED testing
Medical-such as prescriptions, dental, vision
Rent
Transportation- such as car repair, car insurance
Utilities-such as water
Work/job interview related expenses

No, the Betty Proctor Fund cannot generally assist with:

Deposits, Cell Phones, Motels, Storage facilities, Eviction prevention, Paying back family, friends, or roommates, Closed accounts, Bills that must be paid in person, Reimbursement for an expense that is already paid.
