The Action Center Receives Lakewood Sustainability Award

The Food Rescue Program was selected as a recipient of the Community Sustainability Award

LAKESWOOD, CO – The Action Center’s Food Rescue Program was a recipient of the 2016 Lakewood Community Sustainability Award presented at the City of Lakewood Sustainability Awards Ceremony on Monday, April 25 at Lakewood City Council.

Organizations and businesses were honored for their efforts in making Lakewood a more sustainable city.

The Action Center’s Food Rescue Program salvages perishable food items that wholesalers and grocers in our region have set aside as damaged and expendable or close to expiration. As is often the case, only a fraction of those perishable grocery items slated for the garbage are actually unusable. The Action Center identifies these viable pallets of food and “rescues” the items for our clients to consume. During the last fiscal year, The Action Center rescued more than 1.15 million pounds of food through the Food Rescue Program

"We take sustainability and the utilization of best practices very seriously.
